Your first step to learn Urdu

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URDU ALPHABET AND SYSTEM OF transliteration (For parents and teachers)

It is hoped that Waqfeen-e-Nou, having already learned Qa'eda Yassernal Quran, must be familiar with the Arabic alphabet. Urdu, like Arabic and Persian, has a similar alphabet and is written from right to left. The phonetic sounds of the Urdu alphabet is almost the same as that of the Arabic alphabet with the exception of a few. There are six additional letters which are found in Urdu but are not found in Arabic.

It is suggested that the Urdu alphabet is learned with emphasis upon those letters found in Urdu only and the correct pronunciation of these should be practised. The following table will be useful to those people who are not familiar with the Urdu alphabet, its pronunciation and its English equivalent.

Writing Exercise 1

Having learned the alphabet the student should start to practice writing it. To make it easy the alphabet has been written in dotted lines and the student should be instructed to join the dots to complete the letters. It is suggested to photo copy this page and practice writing at least four times.



Lesson 2

It must have been noticed that the Urdu alphabet consists of horizontal lines, dots and circles. To write a word, as in any other language, the letters are joined to one another. The detached form of the alphabet as given on the previous pages, are slightly changed or 'shortened' to take their initial part only and joined to the next letter. This 'shortened form' is called the initial form. In order to obtain the initial form, the horizontal lines and circles are dropped from the detached letters of the alphabet so that the initial form of the alphabet appears as follows:

Lesson 6

Those who have read the Qa'eda Yassernal Quran will be familiar with zabar (ـَ), zer (ـِ) and pesl (ـُ). These are three short vowels used in Urdu. In practice these are not often written or printed in Urdu as compared to Arabic. However, the usage of these short vowels is the same as in Arabic.

ZABAR

When written over a letter, Zabar (ـَ) expresses a short 'a' as بَ BA and نَ NA. It is pronounced like 'u' in the English word 'Fun'.
